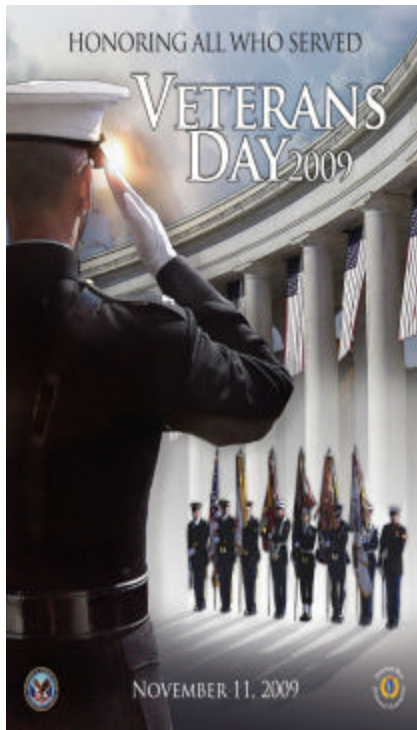

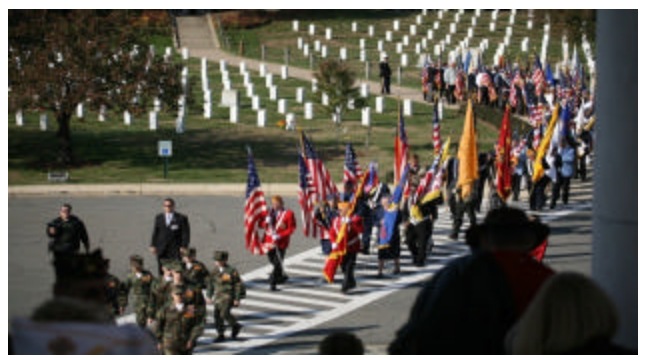

Shop With A Cop Fundraisers

Area law enforcement will once again be raising funds for the annual Shop with a Cop program. The fundraising events include the annual Pizza Hut Night held at Pizza Hut on St Robert Blvd, bake sale on November 25th, t-shirts sales and buckets at area grocers and retailers to collect donations. The Shop with a Cop program

raises money so underprivileged children throughout Pulaski County can have Christmas presents. In December, local law enforcement personnel from each city in Pulaski County, the state patrol, sheriff's department, Fort Leonard Wood military police units, and several other agencies will go to Wal-Mart with the children

for a day of Christmas shopping. Each child receives a gift card to spend on Christmas gifts. Last year Shop with a Cop raised about \$25,000 and was able to provide Christmas to 212 area children. Please come out and support this effort to help needy children in the community.

Golf Consultant Hired



The St. Robert Board of Aldermen accepted the recommendation of the

Park Committee to hire Flatt Golf Services of Jefferson City to develop a concept and cost estimate for a golf practice facility. If approved by Council, the company would then develop a final plan and oversee bidding and construction.

The project would be funded as part of the park improvements paid for by

a 1/4 cent sales tax approved by voters in August.

The plans for the aquatics facility will be completed in November and the city will then seek bids for its construction. Residents will soon notice digging for the infrastructure at the site which is necessary before the actual pool construction begins.

Fire Safety Tips from St. Robert City Fire and Rescue

More than one third of Americans use fireplaces, wood stoves and other fuel fired appliances as primary heat sources in their homes. Heating fires account for 36% of residential fires every year. Often these fires are due to creosote buildup in chimneys and stovepipes. Follow these fire safety tips for winter season to avoid these fire risks:

- Have your chimney or wood stove inspected

and cleaned annually by a certified specialist

- Always use a metal mesh screen with fireplaces. Leave glass doors open while fire is burning.

- Never burn cardboard boxes, trash or debris in your fireplace or wood stove.

- Never leave a fire in a fireplace unattended. Extinguish the fire before going to bed or leaving the house.

- Soak hot ashes in water and place them in a

metal container outside and away from your home. As always, make sure you have working smoke alarms installed on every level of your home.

Following these simple fire safety tips can help you avoid dangerous fire risks.
