\*\* Temporary electric will be installed from the nearest existing utility pole to within 10ft of the property line.

	600 Amp and Below	\$2000.00 includes the first 100ft of line. Plus \$150.00 for every 50ft. there after. Plus the cost of the transformer and switch gear.
	Above 600 Amp	\$3000.00 includes the first 100ft. Plus \$150.00 for every 50ft. there after. Plus actual cost of transformer and switch gear.
	Upgrade existing service	Cost of non-reusable material
<p><b>NOTE:</b> All 3 phase services below 600 amp and single phase services over 400 amp shall have a main disconnect switch supplied by the developer and located at the transformer. (Ordinance # 2048 Section: 800.130.B.5)</p>

### **STREET SWEEPING**

**Construction Sites** – It is the responsibility of the Building Permit Holder to insure that all streets remain free of dirt, mud, vegetation and construction debris in order to protect Public Safety. The permit holder will receive one verbal warning with a deadline to have the debris removed from the street or ROW. If the debris is not removed by the deadline, the city will charge a **\$75.00** fee to clean the street for each instance. Incurred fees must be paid prior to final occupancy.
