The Waynesville-St. Robert Regional Airport is open to the public and provides commercial, round-trip airline service from Fort Leonard Wood to St. Louis multiple times per day.

Those in the region and those visiting the region are able to reduce their time on the road and spend more time with their family members and friends by using the airport for their travel needs.

COMMERCIAL AIR SERVICE

Our commercial airline service partner, Cape Air, provides reliable, safe air service that gets you from Fort Leonard Wood to St. Louis in under an hour. There are four daily round-trip flights every day and five round-trip flights on Fridays between Fort Leonard Wood and St. Louis.

Cape Air has baggage agreements with almost all airlines that ensure your baggage arrives at your final destination with you. When you arrive in St. Louis, Cape Air will provide shuttle service to your connecting airline.

Our airport terminal offers free wi-fi while you wait and a small, friendly staff that is ready to get you in the air on time, without delay. The Waynesville-St. Robert Regional Airport and Cape Air are connecting you to the Fort Leonard Wood Region.



GENERAL AVIATION
